Accommodation and Welfare Arrangements

Regulation requires international students under 18 years of age to live with a parent or approved guardian or carer. Alternatively, students may live at approved homestay accommodation. If you have any concerns about your accommodation arrangements, please notify the International Student Welfare Coordinator.

Fees Payment

The Australian academic school year consists of two semesters with two terms in each semester. Full fee paying overseas students are expected to pay one semester's tuition two weeks prior to the commencement of each semester.

Student Visa

The College has provided you with a Confirmation of Enrolment which would have assisted you in the process of applying for a student visa. Please ensure that your student visa is valid for the entire length of your study at the school.

Prescott College must be informed immediately of any change in living circumstances, including change of accommodation details and local carer/guardian details. The College is legally required to inform Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) of poor attendance, suspension or deferment, all of which will have implications for the ongoing viability of the student's visa.

Health Cover

All international students studying on student visas must have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). OSHC is an insurance that provides cover for the costs of medical and hospital care which international students may need while in Australia. Please ensure that you have organised OSHC and that it is up-to-date.
